Landscapes may be irrigated up to three times a week as needed.

- **Addresses with odd numbers:**
Monday, Wednesday, Saturday
- **Addresses with even numbers:**
Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday.

RESOURCE CONSERVATION SYSTEMS

Resource Conservation Systems is your source of landscape irrigation water. RCS is a private utility with approximately 15,000 customers who rely on us to provide high-quality reclaimed water that would otherwise be wasted.

We serve eight residential communities that include 10 golf courses in Bonita Springs, North Naples, South Fort Myers and Fort Myers. The irrigation water is provided via a dual-water system with two meters. One line carries drinking water and the other supplies the reclaimed irrigation water.

RECLAIMED WATER

“Reclaimed” means water that goes down the drain isn’t wasted. Instead, it goes through an extensive treatment process that was established by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. The purified water is then delivered to keep your landscape lush and green.

Reclaimed water is less expensive than potable (drinking) water, and using it for landscape irrigation reduces demand on Florida’s dwindling fresh-water supplies.

RATES

RCS’s rate schedule rewards lower use with lower costs, based on the South Florida Water Management District’s recommended allowances.

Under: \$1.15 per 1,000 gal.

Over: \$1.61 per 1,000 gal.

ALLOWANCES AND BASE RATES

Base rate is the monthly service charge. Rates and allowances per month are according to customer classification.
