This shall not preclude the Company from discontinuing for non-payment the service covered by this deposit regardless of the sufficiency of said Deposit to cover such indebtedness for such service.

The Company hereby acknowledges the receipt of the Deposit, Account Set-Up, Meter Fee and Contribution in Aid to New Construction Charges for connecting to the mains of the Company by the herein named Customer at the above stated location.

The Customer recognizes and agrees to abide by all existing Rules and Regulations of the Company and any amendments thereto by the signing of this Agreement. Copies of said Rules and Regulations and amendments thereto being available for inspection at the Company's Office.

Among other Rules and Regulations, the Customer agrees that the duly authorized agents of the Company shall have access at all reasonable hours to the premises of the Customer for the purpose of installing, maintaining and inspecting or removing Company's property. This shall also include other purposes incident to performance under the termination of the agreement with the Customer and in such performance shall not be liable for trespass.

<u>Quality of Water</u> - The Company does not in any way represent that the quality of the irrigation water meets State drinking water standards or is suitable for use as construction water. <u>THE</u> <u>IRRIGATION WATER IS TO BE USED FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION PURPOSES</u>. All lines must be underground, and no hose bibs will be allowed on the customer's irrigation system. The Customer is responsible for designing his irrigation system to take into account the quality of the water. This would include, but not limited to: screens/filters located downstream of the meter; strainers on the irrigation heads; and, any other irrigation practices to mitigate for sand, grit, debris and biological matter, which may be in the irrigation delivery system from time to time. The Company is not responsible for discoloration, spotting or rusting of Customer's property and/or the maintenance or replacement of screens/filters downstream of the meter. The Customer should design and install his/her irrigation system to avoid spray onto homes, driveways, walks, automobiles, or other property. <u>THE COMPANY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO UTILIZE TREATED</u> WASTEWATER EFFLUENT AS A SOURCE OF IRRIGATION WATER.

Please adhere to the following rules:

DO NOT drink

**DO NOT** have hose connections on the irrigation system

**DO NOT** fill swimming pools, hot tubs, wading pools, etc.

DO NOT use for recreational activities such as squirt guns, water slides, etc.

The Customer further agrees that all bills for irrigation charges will be paid within twenty (20) days of mailing bills and if not so paid, the Company will have the right to disconnect service after five (5) days written notice and charge a fee for reconnecting.

It is further understood and agreed that the sale of irrigation service to the Customer occurs at the property line and the Company has no responsibility relative to service within the Customer's property line.
